Earn Money for Ocean Shore!

The *Box Tops for Education* program from General Mills is an easy way to raise money for our school by saving coupons on items that we buy regularly, from cereal to food storage bags to taco shells. Many of us have been saving these coupons for years; Ocean Shore received \$1593 last school year. Wouldn't it be great if more people participated and we could increase that? What if we all asked grandparents and neighbors to collect boxtops for us?

The program is changing a bit; newer coupons will be submitted digitally through an app on your phone. For now, there are two kinds of coupons - please consider saving them to help our school.



Send the coupons you have clipped to school; our dedicated volunteers tally them and send them on to General Mills.

Fun fact: you don't have to trim them carefully, just rip them off the box in a way that shows the whole coupon.

Submit the coupon by scanning your grocery store receipt with the Box Tops app on your phone. The app finds the qualifying items and credits the school's account.

Fun fact: While there is an easy way to scan a long receipt in several shots, you can fold the receipt, as long as it shows the items with Box Tops, the date, and the bar code.

Get the app!

Yes, to participate in the scanned receipt program, you do need to download the app, available on the App Store and Google Play. It is actually very easy to use, with clear instructions and feedback - it even gives you more chances if you mess up in some way!
