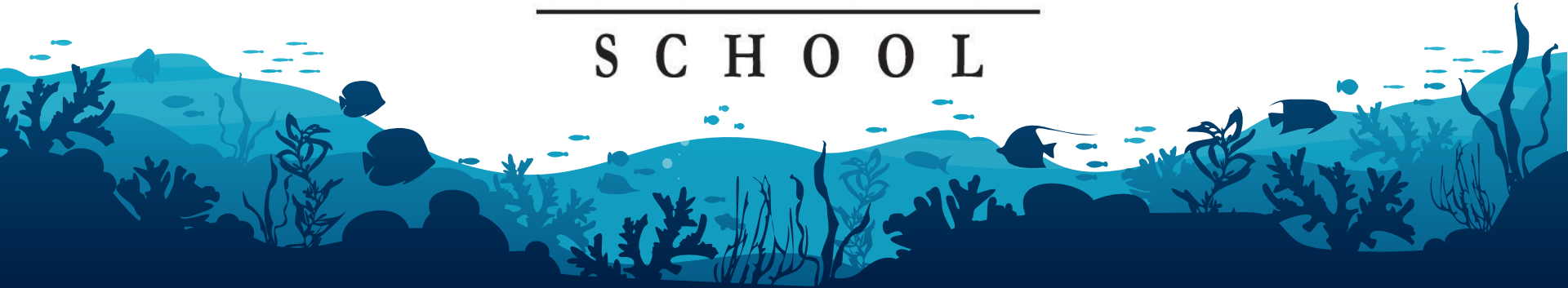



**Fundraising Funds - \$67,500**



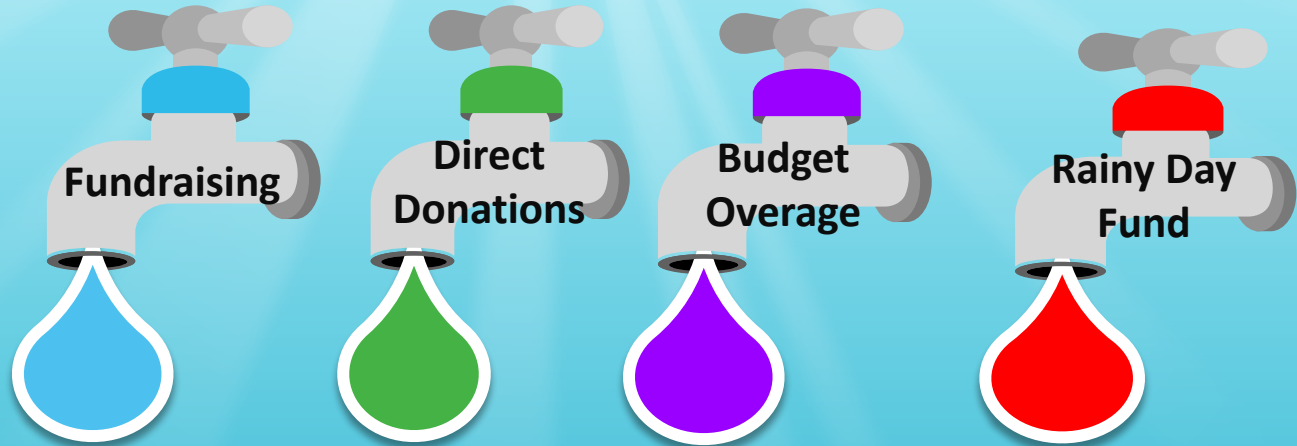
A **rainy day fund** is a reserved amount of money that our organization put aside to use in the case regular funding becomes disrupted.
